1: Vision loss in Canada is expected to grow by 30% in the next ten years due to an ageing population.

2: 1.5 million Canadians are living with vision loss.

3: Over 5.5 million Canadians are living with an eye condition that puts them at significant risk of losing their sight.

4: Fighting Blindness Canada is currently committed to funding research studies focused on understanding eye diseases, preserving and restoring vision and advocating for those living with eye diseases.

5: Fighting Blindness Canada researchers are hard at work discovering ways to slow, stop or reverse vision loss, while increasing our overall understanding of why vision loss occurs.





6: #DYK: 1.5 million Canadians have a seeing disability that impacts their daily life, while another 5.59 million have a disease that puts them at significant risk of losing their vision?
